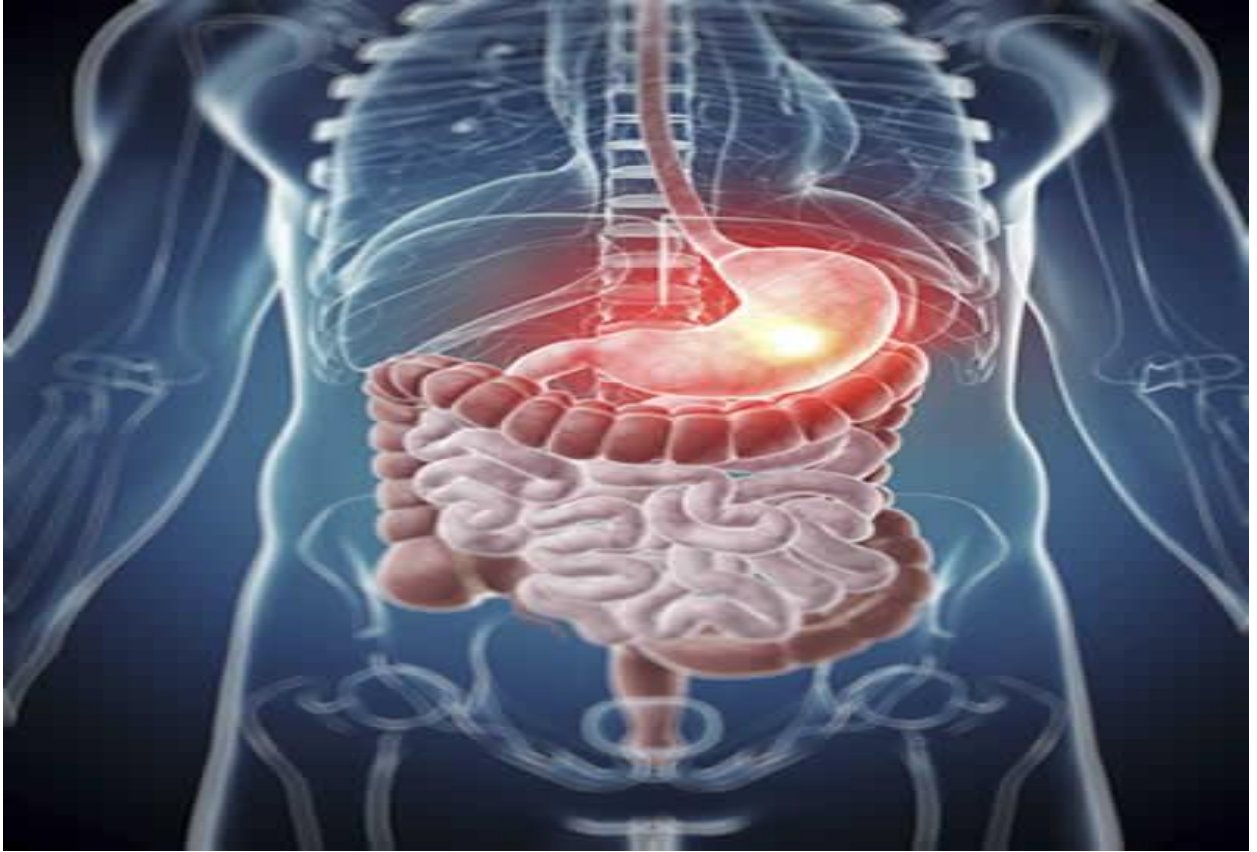

CALL FOR PAPERS

Abstract with Research papers on selected theme will be invited from the researchers, clinicians, academicians and people from allied science working in the field of Kayachikitsa and will be scrutinized by scientific committee.

FORMAT FOR ABSTRACT

- Length of the abstract - 200 words which will include figures, tables & references.
- Title of the abstract - in initial capitals should be written in times roman 12 point bold font with centre alignment.
- Names of all the authors should be written in initial capitals in 10 points times roman font's two spaces below the title, followed by details of all of the authors.
- E-mail address of the author presenting the paper should be written one space below the names and affiliations of the authors.
- The main text of the abstract should be written in times roman 10 points font two spaces below the authors.

FULL PAPER

- Full paper should be written in research paper manner with times roman 10 points fonts with line spacing of 1.5
- All tables and figures should be arranged as close to the relevant portion of the text as possible.

POSTER PRESENTATION

- Space will be available for poster exhibition; criteria of selection will be same as for the papers.
- Poster size 4 x 3ft. with four holes on each corner with rebate.
- Poster should be preferably of flex material.
- Title of the poster followed by name of author and co- authors on the top.
- Details of author and co-authors at the bottom.

SCRUTINY OF PAPERS

1. The papers will be scrutinized by an expert / scientific committee.

2. The selected works graded based on the scientific validation will be included for presentations (oral, poster) at the sessions.
