ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

The global fragrance & flavour industry is \$ 24.10 billion while fragrance & flavour industry in India is around \$ 500 million which is nearly 2% of global fragrance & flavour industry. The size of fragrant raw material, fragrance & flavour industry in India is nearly \$ 2450 million which is nearly 10% of the global fragrance & flavour industry. This fragrance & flavour industry has been growing at a rate of 10 - 11 % in India.

This growth needs to be accelerated by synergizing all the relevant stakeholders like Govt. institutions, industry and growers to make India a global leader. There are number of Institutions and Industry associations that are working on it. A number of them are working in isolation leading to duplicity of the work, and in a large number of cases research work is done without considering the needs of the Industry. Such efforts do produce some good scientific papers but neither contributes to the growth of the relevant Industry nor to the GDP of the nation. Above all, it is very important that both industry and farmers need to be made aware of the scientific developments so as to decide what, where and when to grow to get back the maximum output.

In order to avoid such duplicity of efforts and to work in a complementary mode, this workshop is being organized to evolve a road map on these issues through deliberations and interactions with relevant Government organizations, Industry & industry associations and farmers. The present workshop is being organised jointly by Fragrance & Flavour Development Centre (FFDC), an Autonomous Body under Ministry of MSME and Central Institute of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants (CSIR-CIMAP), under Ministry of Science & Technology will enable us to build a roadmap for India to become Global Leader in essential oils, fragrance & flavor Industry.

This is for the first time when all leading relevant R&D organizations such as CSIR-CIMAP, IIIM Jammu, IHBT Palampur, Perfumer & Flavour Dept. ICT Mumbai, Chemical Division FRI Dehradun and FFDC, Kannauj has come together with all leading industry association i.e. EOAI, FAFAI, ICEOFF and Attar & Perfumers Association Kannauj along-with farmers & Ministry of MSME to discuss about challenges & prospectus at different level right from cultivation up to marketing. Needless to say that senior official of Ministry of MSME will be there to discuss about the Govt. schemes & approaches. This will end-up in a clear Fragrant Road Map for essential oil, fragrance & flavour sector.
