Ayurveda is not folklore or an herbal tradition. The standard textbooks of Ayurveda trace its history to the vedic and post-vedic periods (circa 3500 BC). There are several scholastic and profound books, monographs and theses on the history of Ayurveda and its continuity till date. No herbal or folklore traditions have such an organized approach to their development. The differences between a herbal/folklore tradition and a system of health-care are based on several criteria, like basic philosophy, the theory about the nature of man, authentic textbooks and degree-curricula, research, etc.

Evidence In Ayurveda & Life Sciences

In Ayurveda, there are defined means of knowledge and modes of evidence as the foundation:

- (1) Apta: unbiased and intuitive direct knowledge of the masters,
- (2) Pratyaksha: observational data from the senses or their extensions,
- (3) Anumana: derivative evidence due to a constant association,
- (4) Upamana: evidence by analogy or similarity of the variables and lastly
- (5) Yukti: facts ascertained from a planned intervention to test an idea or evaluate an observation.

It is often not known in the west that such an approach to evidence exists as a lasting foundation of Ayurveda. The goal of the present brief review is to provide practical examples of the type of evidence in Ayurveda. It is impossible to provide an exhaustive coverage of evidence. The selected examples of evidence will be given under the broad specialties of Ayurveda.

Valid knowledge in Ayurveda

Even in Rigveda, there is a reference to Pramā (valid knowledge). It has been defined, as the apprehension of an object as it really is to know the objects of the world as they are, is therefore an important commitment in Indian culture, at its inception. Several schools existed to explore validity - inner and outer. These darshanas (dominant schools of thought-systems) formed the foundation of Ayurveda as well as other secular sciences in India. There were debates on the possible instruments of valid knowledge, the chances of error and false conjectures. Consensus often emerged after the debates as documented by Ayurveda textbooks.

Future Directions for Evidence-Path in Ayurveda & Life Sciences Based

Ayurveda has to evolve a unique path to gather and generate evidence that would stand the rigor of scientific scrutiny. But the nature of scientific evidence has to expand itself to include Ayurvedic definitions of testing the reality of truth viz. Apta, Pratyaksha, Anumana, Upamana and Yukti. Holistic and integrative approach demands that novel clinical and experimental models of evidence have to be created based on Ayurvedic Epistemology. There is a need to evolve Ayurvedic statistics.

Over the last several decades, India has evolved totally different pluralistic model health care. Now at the primary health level an integrative medicine path has opened up. The current national level decision to allocate resources for the new paths will encourage major projects through:

- 1) Golden Triangle Approach
- 2) Reverse Pharmacology for natural drug development

3) Systems Biology couples with ethnomedicine.

India would then emerge world leader in integrative health care, by evolving an economical, safe and effective path of health promotion, disease prevention and management. The other nations of the World can expedite this journey by accepting Ayurveda as a system of health-care.
