Shri N.P.A. Govt. Ayurved College Raipur is spread in a huge, 89.3 Acres of lush green eco-friendly campus. For this the famous Malgujar Late Shri Narayan Prasad Awasthi ji donated five villages. In 1979 Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicin and Surgery (B.A.M.S.) course designed by CCIM guidelines and the students were awarded degree from Ravishankar University, Raipur. In 2006 Ayurveda vachaspati postgraduate courses in Ayurveda Siddhant (3 Seats), Rachana Sharir (3 Seats), Rashashastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana (3 Seats) and Ayurveda Dhanwantari postgraduate courses in Shalya Tantra (3 Seats) started. In 2014 Ayurveda vachaspati postgraduate courses in Dravyaguna (6 Seats) and Roga Nidan & Vikriti Vigyan (6 Seats) courses started.


