## Background

With drastic changes in life style, dietetic habits, increased industrialization, and pollution; population of current scenario is affecting with various kinds of Non Communicable Diseases (NCDs) like diabetes that is fast gaining the status of a potential epidemic in India. Unless addressed in time; the mortality and disease burden from these diseases will continue to increase.

Ayurveda can play a major preventive, curative and promotive role in community health. In view of this; it is considered of supporting AYSUH activities in 12<sup>th</sup> Planning Commission. It emphasizes on different concepts in breaking the pathologies at different levels that can be equally useful in treating NCDs that can play a crucial role in restricting complications, improving quality of life. Simple changes in life style blended with implementation of diet and daily routine can prevent and have huge impact on such manifestations.

Considering this, Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India has launched '**Mission Madhumeha**' to offer the best solutions through Ayurveda on the occasion of National Ayurveda Day on 28<sup>th</sup> October 2016.

This is the right time to think and discuss about the impact of Ayurveda practices in maintaining and preventing debilitating diseases such as Diabetes.

Looking into this need; an attempt is being made through a Symposium **Madhu Samvaada** to bring together the practicing physicians, scientists and researchers from all over the country to discuss the recent concerns, advances, future strategies in the management of diabetes during 17<sup>th</sup> -18<sup>th</sup> March 2017. These deliberations are anticipated in providing a strong lead for further researches and in deriving needful policy recommendations. At the end of the endeavor we will be able to come out of Protocols for management of Diabetes and its complications through Ayurveda.

## THEME OF THE SEMINAR

- ★ Life Style Interventions & Yoga in prevention and management of Madhumeha (Diabetes mellitus)
- ★ Strategies for the management of Madhumeha (Diabetes mellitus) through Ayurveda
- ★ Management of Madhumeha (Diabetes mellitus) in special cases like gravid women, pediatrics etc.
- ★ Approach for management of complications of Madhumeha (Diabetes mellitus).
- ★ Pre-clinical safety and efficacy of Ayurveda medicinal plants and formulations used in the management of Madhumeha (Diabetes mellitus)

Four plenary sessions are planned during the symposium, where eminent speakers will share their views in the field of diabetes. This will be followed by Parallel Scientific Sessions that will hold Key Note speeches and Free Oral Presentations on the theme. In addition to this, a space for poster presentations is also allocated.

**Call for papers:** Original unpublished research papers from scientists and scholars are invited for the presentation in the symposium. The received abstracts will be screened preliminarily for the suitability with the theme and shortlisted ones will be communicated in advance. For every free paper, oral presenter will get about eight minutes time. Parallel to this, poster presentations also will be conducted. Two best papers from the respective themes will be adjudicated during the event.

**Format for abstract submission:** Original, unpublished structured abstracts in MS word, Times New Roman fonts, 12 pts, 1½ line space, not exceeding 250 words. The abstract should include- Title, Name(s) of the author(s), Affiliations, Communicating details, Theme (under which abstract is being submitted), Structured abstract, Key words (3-5)

### Details for Poster presentation:

#### a. Preparation of posters:

- \* Posters should be addressing the theme and be scientific, simple, brief and self-explanatory.
- \* As poster should be readable by more than one person at the same time, an appropriate font size is to be selected.

#### b. Poster material and content:

- ❖ Posters are to be printed on flex.
- ❖ Each poster presentation must have a title including the title of the paper, author(s), organization details. Figures and tables with simple legends may be added to make the poster self-explanatory.
- ❖ Size of poster should not be more than 5 feet (height) x 3 feet (width).
- ❖ Best posters will be awarded and retained by the institute.

**Note:** An undertaking from the Head of the institution stating that the abstract / article being communicated is original and not published or presented anywhere is to be produced by the authors while submitting the abstract
