The conference aims at to provide a national platform for both the young and experienced scholars to share their views over these burning issues of today's era.

All abstracts will be subjected to an extensive review process and the decision of the scientific committee would be considered final regarding the acceptance and the type of presentation i.e. oral or poster. Selected abstracts will be called for full papers for publishing in conference proceedings with ISBN No., after the completion of the conference.
