NUTRICON

By WHO standards nearly 40% of the worlds stunted children are Indian. Stunting is not simple a function of poor nutrition being given to children but is said to commence in utero, during gestation. It is also found that the quality of nutrition afforded to the developing foetus is determined by the nutritional status of the mother to be, especially during her own childhood. Effectiveness of nutrition given to the child depends on the bio-availability of the food ingested and the absorptive capacity of the intestinal mucosa. Many foods even if rich in protein, carbohydrates, fats, minerals and vitamins are in complex forms that are poorly absorbed or are unbalanced. Water is a major factor in nutrition. Water that is contaminated will cause recurrent gastro-enteritis with attendant mal-absorption.

In addition to stunting, this conference has focus on the growing silent epidemic of chronic non-communicable diseases such as diabetes, hypertension, ischemic heart disease-stroke complex. India already is the largest reservoir of diabetes in the world. Hypertension and ischemic conditions affecting brain, kidney, eye wreak havoc to health, affecting the well-being and productivity of the population.

The organizing committee invites abstract of original research work related to the conference themes and subthemes. Authors are requested to send their research work in the form of abstract. The abstract is to be submitted online through the SHIATS portal or by email on: nutricon2017@shiats.edu.in.

Instruction for abstract submission

- Abstract must be submitted in English
- Abstract title must be limited to 30 words
- The body of the abstract (excluding title, Authors and their affiliations) should not exceed 350 words
- No charts or graphic should be included in the abstract.
- All abstracts accepted for oral/poster presentation will be published in the abstract Book
- All abstracts should be submitted online either through SHUATS website or by email.

Instruction for Poster Presentation

1. On spot presentation

- Poster size -3ft wide and 4 ft high (36 in W × 48 in H)
- The poster should have the following format
- Title
- Names of authors
- The presenters name should be formatted as bold
- Institutional Affiliations of the authors
- E mail of presenting authors
- Main body should comprise abstract, introduction, materials and method, results, significance, importance references and acknowledgement.

2. E-poster

• Poster size - (slide of power point)

- The poster should have the following format
- Title
- Names of authors
- The presenters name should be formatted as bold
- Institutional Affiliations of the authors
- E-mail of presenting authors
- Main body should comprise abstract, introduction, materials and method, results, significance, importance references and acknowledgement.
- E-poster should be made in single page, landscape orientation with a pixel dimension of 1920 pixels x 1080 pixels. The font size should be sufficient enough to get an optimal, readable display on a 42" LED/LCD Screen
- Windows compatible JPEG format files are only accepted with a maximum file size of 4
 MB
- Avoid dark coloured backgrounds and fonts. Arial font is recommended
- The components of the E-poster are: Title, Names and affiliations of authors as one section and separate sections for Introduction, Materials and methods, Results and Conclusion.
- Mail the e-poster to nutricon2017@shiats.edu.in positively before 31st july 2017. Late submissions will not be entertained.
- You are also required to carry a backup copy of the e-poster during the scheduled presentation to avoid any data/digital error (s)

Oral presentation

- The time for oral presentation is 8 minutes with 2 additional minutes for discussion
- The presentation should be prepared in power point format and to be mailed to the organizing secretary prior to the conference.
