- Application sent after the due date or incomplete in any respect will summarily be rejected.
- The maximum number of participants will be 30 only and the selection of candidates will be done on the basis of first come first serve basis.
- A maximum of 05 participants are allowed from one state.
- The selected candidates will be informed through e-mail or over the telephone by the coordinator of the CME. After confirmation of candidature, candidate has to submit a copy of his/her ADHAAR card, PAN card and Bank Pass Book.
- A candidate is allowed to attend maximum of two CME prorgammes in a year.

**Payment of T.A.**

- After the end of the training progaramme and achieving full attendance, the participant will be reimbursed with actual fair (up to rail fare AC 2 tier) on production of original tickets for inward journey and copy of ticked of return journey as per the norms of the Government of India. Local participants will not be entitled for any TA/DA except training materials.

**Boarding and lodging charges**


As per the rules of Government of India, all the outstation participants will be provided with local hospitality in the premises nearby the institution. No payment for the same will be provided in any case.
