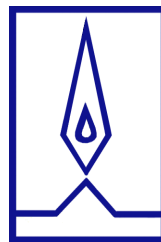

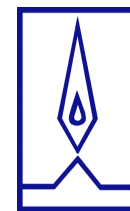

## About Chitrakoot

Chitrakoot is one of the famous place of pilgrimage of Hindus in India. It is situated in the border of Satna district of Madhya Pradesh and Chitrakoot district of Uttar Pradesh. It is well connected by road and train routes from Satna, Manikpur, Allahabad and Karwi. It is famous for its religious importance, elegant environment and spiritual peace. It has been centre of devotion, dedication and faith of devout persons of Lord Ram.

## Our Institute

Arogyadham, Deendayal Research Institute, is situated in a scenic location at Chitrakoot in the Satna District of Madhya Pradesh, surrounded by Vindhya mountain range and located on the bank of the perennial Mandakini River. It was established by Hon'ble Nanaji Deshmukh in 1997 as J.R.D. Tata Foundation for Research in Ayurveda & Yoga Sciences and spread over 43 acres. The Institute aimed at providing a model for the realization of a new life system, by taking a total overview of human development with Yoga, Naturopathy & Ayurveda. The nearest railway station Chitrakootdham Karvi is about 15 km away and Satna 80 km from the Institute.

## Ayurveda Sadan (Research Lab)

Although the evidence of the effectiveness of ayurveda as an alternative to curing diseases and maintaining a healthy body is available in abundance, there is a lack of standardization and scientific validation of the herbs and preparations used in ayurveda. This is a great hindrance in its acceptability worldwide.

To overcome this shortcoming, the research centre consists of five modern labs viz. **Pharmacognosy, Genetics & molecular biology, Tissue culture, Core instrumentation facilities and Microbiology**, with the latest scientific equipments to standardize and validate ayurvedic herbs, in accordance with allopathic protocols and to isolate the active ingredients, so that, in the future, the preparation can be presented as 'medicine' that is acceptable worldwide.

## Scope and Objectives of the Workshop

Ayurvedic drugs are being used all over the globe in present time. The demand of herbal medicines for health is increasing day by day. The evidence of effectiveness of Ayurveda in curing diseases and attaining good health is available in abundance but no systematic scientific studies have been done to prove this. However the acceptability and future prospects of these medicines depends on the quality and safety measures.

It is high time that all the stakeholders should concentrate on the safety and quality aspects of these drugs so that the benefit of efficacious drugs may be passed on to Ayurveda & allied fraternities in correct form. The outcomes of this event are to enhance the knowledge about Ayurvedic drugs and promote their uses, create awareness about safety and quality of Ayurvedic drugs for research practice and also to sensitize stakeholders about toxicity.

The purpose of this conference is to provide a forum for the researchers, scientists/academicians and others to discuss issues related to the following thrust areas -

- Traditional system of medicine
- Challenging and emerging dimensions in AYUSH/Herbal products
- Quality, safety and efficacy of AYUSH drugs
- Role of sophisticated instruments (viz. UV, HPLC, HPTLC, GC, MS and AAS) drug development
- Status, cultivation and conservation of medicinal plants.
- Recent approach for determination of toxicity in herbal drugs
- Role of botanical identification to detection of adulterants in AYUSH/Herbal products
- GMP, GLP and their role in quality, safety and efficacy of AYUSH/Herbal products
- Development of SOPs for herbal, mineral and metallic preparation.
- Conservation and management of biodiversity
- Ethnobiology and human welfare.
- Ethnomedicinal practices of tribals.
- Agricultural research (including plant breeding, animal husbandry, horticulture, agronomy, soil science etc.)
