The application should reach by post (Advance copy) of application duly signed and scanned through E-mail as mentioned in table immediately but not later than respective dates mentioned in the table.


The selection of the candidates will be subject to the following guidelines:

1. Participants should attend all the sessions on all six days of the program. Participation certificate will be issued on the last day only after completion of the program.
2. Arrangements for accommodation, food etc. will be provided by the institute.
3. Participants should produce the original tickets or receipts for payment of TA charges. Actual fare will be reimbursed subject top eligibility limiting maximum up to 2 Tier A.C. Rail fare as per the conditions and principles laid down.
4. The applications should be countersigned and duly certified by the head of the Institution/ Controlling authority to the effect that the candidate is a regular teacher in the concerned department and that he/she has not attended more than two such programs during the current financial year.
5. Participants should enclose self-attested copies of educational qualifications – PG degree certificate, State/ CCIM Registration Certificate & original Identity Card of the Institute along with the application.
6. Application not containing full Bio-data including Name, Address with Pin Code, Phone No. (Land & Mobile) and E-Mail ID/ FAX, will not be considered.
7. Only those candidates whose selection has been confirmed by this Institute should be deputed for the training.

Payment of TA:

- Actual fare or up to the rail fare of AC 2 tier class, whichever is less.
- Payment of TA & journey DA will be made only at the end of the program.
- Food expenses during journey up to maximum Rs.175/- is payment on production of bills. No food expenses will be paid if journey is made by Shatabdi/ Rajdhani/ Duronto trains.
- Payments will be made directly to the bank account by electronic transfer.
- Reimbursement of the journey performed by road is permissible for the places which are not connected by rail. The road mileage will be limited to 1 AC rail charges or actual claim, whichever is lower.
- Please be noted that TATKAL or DYNAMIC PRICING train tickets will not be reimbursed.
- The payment of TA and food bills shall be made only on production of original tickets.

Lodging and Boarding of the trainees:

- Trainees will be provided with best possible lodging and boarding facility within the budget limits of the CME.
