ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Government College, Sri Ganganagar (Rajasthan), INDIA is a pioneer co-educational institution in the region to provide opportunities of education to students coming from rural and economically weaker sections of the society in and around Sri Ganganagar. It was initially established as a Secondary School in 1939 by Maharaja Ganga Singh. It was promoted to an



Intermediate College in 1946, and graduated to a higher seat of learning in 1954 as Graduation College in Arts and in 1960 with Graduation in Science. The Post Graduation studies began in the college in 1968. The name of the college was changed from Government College to Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Government College in 2009 by the orders of the State Government. The college was initially affiliated to University of Rajasthan, Jaipur; in 1987 the affiliation was shifted to M.D.S. University, Ajmer. Later on by the orders of the Government of Rajasthan, it was affiliated to the University of Bikaner (presently named as Maharaja Ganga Singh University, Bikaner) in 2003. Presently, the college is a premier institution in academics for educating the students for the degrees of Bachelors, Masters, M. Phil. and Ph.D. in various disciplines.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

Department of Geography in Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Govt. College, Sri Ganganagar, Rajasthan is one of the oldest departments in the state of Rajasthan, which was established in 1969. At present, there are seven posts of faculty members in the department, of which two posts are vacant. There are five associate professors in the department. Two sections of 60 students in each post graduation are running apart from 6 sections of 100 students in each under graduate courses in the Geography department. Earlier the department had organized three national conferences under the banner of Rajasthan Geographical Association in 1976, 1998 and 2008 respectively. The department has produced 26 Ph.D. students, apart from more than 100 M.Phil. students. At present there are 6 ongoing Ph.D. research works in the department and 9 projects have been completed in the department, funded by UGC and ICSSR.
