National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC) has accorded this University the most coveted "A+" grade. This college has an ISO 2009-2015 Certification. It is a pioneer institute in Maharashtra that provides Pharm.D and Pharm.D (PB) education and training. UGC has accorded to this college a status of Departmental Research Support (DRS) under its Special Assistance Programme (SAP). AICTE has identified this college for its Quality Improvement Programme (QIP) for teachers and Entrepreneurship Development Cell for students.
