(Last date of essay submission - 31 March, 2019)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The participant must be a bonafide student of an Ayurveda College or University.
2. The essay should be written in **ENGLISH**
3. The essay should not be more than 3000(three thousand words)
4. The essay should be written in MS word file (doc.docx)
5. Font size-Time New Roman, Font size 12, Spacing 1.5
6. Individual entries to be submitted **ONLY IN SOFT COPIES** via weblink received.

7. **Only one submission is allowed per author.** Co-authorship is not permitted.
8. The submission shall consist of an abstract, essay, bibliography Footnotes, if any must conform to authoritative standard rules of legal citation.
9. Verbatim of the internet sources or from the journals on the mentioned topic will not be accepted. **Only original work will be appreciated.**
10. No part of it should have been published earlier nor should it be under consideration for publication or a contest elsewhere.
11. Any form of plagiarism will result in disqualification of the essay.
12. All participants should strictly abide by the guidelines. Any deviance shall lead to disqualification.
13. The decision regarding acceptance, rejection and the award of the prizes for the essay would be solely of The Rog Nidan Parishad, India and remain abiding to all the participants.
