Dear Students

Vaidya Uddhavdas Mehta was born on 9th August 1911 in bhopal in a reputed Family after completing the Degree in Sanskrit and Ayurveda from Kashi, he started his clinical practice. Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya ji was his idol. He devoted his life for Hindi, Hindu and Hindustan. Although he was engaged as an Ayurvedic practitioner and treating the poor community free of cost but given more priority to social services. His struggle against the terror and exploitation against the Nawabi regime of Bhopal State gave consolation to Hindu Population. As a mark of respect he became popular by the name of Bhai ji.

He started his public life in 1926. Bhai ji gave memorandum to nawab of Bhopal in 1930 on the behalf of Hindu Conference. In 1934, He Started one weekly Hindi Magazine Praja Pukar. In 1937 Bhaiji was arrested for leading first freedom movement and imprisoned for 6 months. He became Sanghchalak in Bhopal in 1940. Again he was arrested in 1944 for addressing a rally. People became violent when he was arrested in 1949 while leading villeenikaran movement.

Basically, he was a physician and a social worker but due to exisiting situation of bhopal state he was compelled to lead the work of Hindu Mahasabha. Later he joined jansangh by the request of Late Kusabhau Thakre & Late Pt. Deendayal Upadhy. Although he joined politics but he could not leave his active social services. He had established an excellent coordination between profession, social service and politics, These were the qualities and reson of Bhai ji ruled over the heart of people. Even today, he is remembered with full respect and devotion for his excellent personality and contribution.
